Test Case/Scenario ID	UAT001	Feature Being Tested	Login	
Test Objective	Ensure that the login feature works as intended and allows users to access their account.			
Test Steps	 Navigate to the login page. Enter a valid email address and password. Click the "Login" button. 			
Expected Results	The user should be logged into their account and redirected to the dashboard.			
Pass/Fail Criteria	The test passes if the user is able to log in and access their account without any errors. The test fails if the user encounters any errors or is unable to access their account.			
Notes/Observations	If the test fails, record any error messages or issues encountered during the testing process.
